Kidney transplant

In a historic accomplishment, a team led by Dr. Sachin Soni, Consultant Intervention Nephrologist, Medicovert Hospitals, Aurangabad gave a second lease of life to a patient by performing World’s first HIV positive living Donor to HIV positive Recipient ABO Incompatible Kidney Transplant. Addressing to media persons along with team of doctors Dr Soni said that the patient suffered from kidney disease and was on CAPD home dialysis for the last three years. Both patients have been discharged from the hospital recovering well and are now able to go about their daily activities with ease. A 46-year-old resident, a cotton trader from Beed District was detected to be HIV positive in 2008 and was started on Antiretroviral Therapy. He was detected with severe Hypertension and kidney failure in 2019. He first approached Dr. Soni in 2020 and was treated with home dialysis (CAPD continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis) for the last 3

years. His health condition gradually deteriorated leaving him tired and weak. Option of kidney transplant was discussed with the family members of the patient. The patient’s 42-year-old wife who is also HIV positive came forward as kidney donor to save the life of her husband,said Dr Soni. Both are taking regular Antiretroviral Therapy. However, her blood group was different (B+ve) than patients’ blood group (A +ve). Based on expertise in managing ABO incompatible (Blood Group Mismatch) Kidney transplant cases, Dr. Soni accepted the challenge after counselling the relatives about the complexities involved. Patient’s wife was determined to save her husband’s life, said Dr Soni. Following the guidelines for performing transplants in HIV-positive patients complete health check-up was done in September 2022. After confirming the eligibility of both the donor and recipient, necessary legal formalities

were completed. Permission for Kidney Transplantation was obtained from District Authorization Committee based in Aurangabad. The surgery was performed successfully on January 18, Dr. Soni stated. “The immunity of HIV patients is already low and the medicines used during the transplant can weaken the immunity of such patients further. We monitored the viral load of the patients and carried out the transplant with the help of modified medicine doses and treatment for these patients. The surgery lasted for about four hours and was uneventful. Entire team comprising the Nephrologists, Surgeons, assistants, nursing staff and helpers followed necessary precautions in view of HIV patients. The donor was discharged on January 24 and the recipient was discharged on January 31 in good clinical condition. This case report will be published in the Journal soon,” Dr. Soni explained.

ISRO successfully tests launch vehicles engine

‘Stable combustion & subsystem performance’

Chennai, Feb 10: Marking yet another milestone , the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) successfully tested the Vikas engine for workhorse launch vehicles, including the versatile, PSLV, GSLV and LMV.

The engine with a nominal thrust of 80t

can power the second stages of PSLV & GSLV, liquid strapons of GSLV and the core liquid stage of LVM3. Liquid engines that support throttling of the engine thrust facilitate booster stage recovery in launch vehicles.

In order to enable booster stage recovery in future launch vehicle

configurations, the first throttling demonstration hot test of the Vikas engine was successfully accomplished on January 30, 2023 for a targeted 67 per cent thrust level throttling for a duration of 43 secs, ISRO said. Throttling of the engine was achieved by a closed loop thrust regulation system and

the engine had been successfully throttled from the chamber pressure of 58.5 bar in steps of 50 bar, 45 bar & 40 bar, with dwelling at each pressure level for 7 s. In addition, the Vikas engine was also throttled down to 45 per cent for the final 3s before the engine shut down.

The results of the first hot test of Throttletable Vikas engine indicate stable combustion and subsystem performed in accordance with the prediction. The overall performance of engine sub-systems, control systems and test facility systems were as expected.

Lotus will bloom more in mud-slinging: Modi

New Delhi, Feb 10: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday came down heavily on the Opposition saying "the more you engage in mud-slinging", the more "Lotus" will bloom.

"To create new narratives, efforts are being made to spread lies with half-baked things. The more you engage in mud-slinging, the more Lotus will bloom," Modi said in his reply in Rajya Sabha to the debate on the 'Motion of Thanks' to the President's address to the Parliament, in an apparent attack on the Opposition.

Taking a swipe at the previous Congress Governments at the Centre, the PM accused it of "misgovernance".

"For 60 years, the Congress had made potholes. Maybe they didn't intend, but they did. When they were digging pits, they had wasted six decades then when even small countries of the world were touching the heights of success," said Modi.

He added, "Congress politics, economic policy and social policy used to run on the basis of vote bank only. But we are worried about street vendors. Through PM-Swanidhi and PM-Vikas Yojana, we have worked to increase the capacity of a large section of the society."

The PM said, "Over 90,000 startups have opened opportunities for jobs for people. Small farmers are the backbone of India's agriculture sector. Government is working to strengthen them."

He remarked, "We have transformed the working culture with the

power of technology. Our focus is on increasing speed and enhancing scale."

The PM also claimed that record investment has been done in the infrastructure sector, thus creating employment opportunities for the people.

"We are working hard

and working on the basis of the public's priorities and needs. If we have to work day and night, we will do it, but will not let the hopes of the country get hurt," he added.

He further said, "The world was amazed when we developed indigenous vaccines for COVID.

India has not fulfilled just its needs but of 150 countries for the vaccine."

He added, "We have focused on national progress and also paid attention to regional aspirations. It is our resolve that India becomes 'Viksit Bharat' by 2047."

Cong promises to make Meghalaya 5 star State

Assures Rs. 3,000 pm for single mothers

Shillong, Feb 10: In the run-up to the assembly election in Meghalaya, the Congress party on Thursday kick-started its poll campaign in the State with a theme of making "Meghalaya a five star State", even as it announced a sop of Rs. 3000 per month to single mothers from the BPL families and jobs to deserving candidates from every household if voted to power.

Declaring five commitments to achieve this goal of making "Meghalaya a five star state" State Congress chief, Vincent H. Pala said there would be a direct transfer of Rs 3,000 per month to single BPL mothers raising their children alone.

"This (direct transfer) will empower women and give them financial independence to run their houses better. Rs 3,000 a month translates to Rs 36,000 a year. It is a substantial amount and will help women pay the school fees

of their children and tame inflation," Pala told reporters.

Promising that the party is committed to bringing Meghalaya youth out of the situation of despondence and dejection, the Congress leader said the party's second commitment is to provide one job to deserving candidate from every household. "Lack of decent employment opportunities in the state has fuelled the desperation amongst our youngsters and they are compelled to migrate to far-flung cities of New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata to meet their basic needs," he said.

The Opposition Trinamool Congress also announced a slew of freebies in its manifesto from doling out monthly allowance to women, entrepreneurs and youths. However, the highest such monthly allowance announced by the TMC is Rs. 2500. The TMC has promised creation of 3 lakh jobs opportunities

in five years.

Asked where the fund would come from in this cash-strapped state, Congress leaser Pala said the requisite fund to implement the scheme can be received by stopping revenue leakages.

"There is lot of revenue leakages in the State and if these are plugged we can

easily implement this scheme. We will ensure that such revenue leakages are stopped and our next commitment is to make Meghalaya a corruption free state," he said, adding that the Congress would bring transparency in laws and other monitoring mechanisms.

NSA Doval calls on Russia President Putin in Moscow

New Delhi, Feb 10: Indian National Security Advisor Ajit Doval on Thursday called on Russian President Vladimir Putin in Moscow during

which the two held wide-ranging talks on bilateral and regional issues, and agreed to continue the work towards implementing the bilateral strategic

partnership.

The Indian Embassy in Russia in a tweet said: "NSA Ajit Doval called on HE President Putin. Wide-ranging discussion on bilateral

and regional issues. Agreed to continue work towards implementing the India-Russia strategic partnership."

Ajit Doval is in Moscow to attend the Fifth Regional Dialogue on Afghanistan of security chiefs held on Wednesday. President Putin had dropped in during the meeting and addressed the gathering.

Apart from the host country Russia and India, the other countries participating in the meeting are Iran, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, China, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan.

Various issues related to Afghanistan were discussed, including the security situation and humanitarian challenges facing Afghanistan.

Kim Jong Un, general

secretary of the Workers' Party of Korea and chairman of the State Affairs Commission of the DPRK, attended and reviewed the military parade, said the report.

According to the report, the celebration saw a stunt show of the country's air force. It also displayed the army's main military hardware to show "advanced, modern and strong nature of the DPRK's defense
