Police warns action against use of 'G' in number plates

Chennai, May 12: With rampant misuse of government labels or 'G' stickers on number plates of private vehicles, police on Tuesday kickstarted a crackdown against these vehicles.

Being the first day of the crackdown, drivers were advised to remove

the 'G' stickers from the number plates. The action comes after a large number of drivers were found misusing the 'G' stickers.

The Transport Commissioner has warned action against the vehicles owned by the State owned companies, public sector companies and welfare

boards illegally affixing letter 'G' in their number plate.

An official release of the Transport Commissioner said that there are complaints that non-government vehicles across the State illegally affixing the letters 'G or G' on the number plate.

According to Section 3 (K) of the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicle Act, a government vehicle means a Government of Tamil Nadu vehicle only. "Government vehicles are exempted from the road tax and insurance. Therefore the letters 'G or G' should be used only on the vehicles of the Government of Tamil Nadu which are eligible for the relevant tax and insurance exemption," the release said, warning that action will be taken under the Motor Vehicles Act against the use of the letters 'G or G' in the vehicles of State Owned Companies, Boards and Public Sector Undertakings other than Tamil Nadu Government Vehicles.

Rs. 363 cr world's largest film restoration project begins

Chennai, May 12:

After years of efforts, India moved with an earmarked budget allocation for the world's largest film restoration project under National Film Heritage Mission. The restoration project now awarded would commence at the National Film Archive of India (NFAI) to achieve the goal.

Sharing this on Thursday, Union Minister of Information and Broadcasting Anurag Thakur said that a hefty budget of Rs 363 crore has been allotted to take up the world's largest film restoration project under the National Film Heritage Mission by the ministry. Thakur detailed that about 2200 Indian

films would undergo restoration under the National Film Heritage Mission.

"The titles of films have already been shortlisted language-wise by committees consisting of filmmakers, documentary

filmmakers, film historians and producers for their restorations", Thakur informed the media. Besides this, he said that the National Film Heritage Mission also is also handling the ongoing preservation processes of film condition assessment, preventive conservation and digitization with a total allocated budget of Rs 597 crores. This is one of the world's largest film preservation missions.

Under NFHM, approximately 2,200 films will undergo restoration. The titles have been shortlisted by forming language wise committees consisting of filmmakers, documentary

filmmakers, film historians, producers etc. Eminent film personalities such as Aparna Sen, Shriram Raghavan, Anjali Menon and Vetrimaan were part of the committees.
