Tata commissions 198 MW captive wind project

Chennai, Feb 6: Tata Power Renewable Energy Limited (TPREL), a subsidiary of The Tata Power Company Limited, has successfully commissioned a 198 MW wind energy project for Tata Steel under the Group Captive model at Karur in Tamil Nadu. Described as one of the largest wind projects of its kind, the development marks a significant milestone in India's renewable energy landscape, the company said in a release on Tuesday.

The project consists of 55 wind turbine generators, each with a capacity of 3.6 MW, and is designed to generate around 31 million units of clean electricity annually. This will support Tata Steel's decarbonisation goals while strengthening TPREL's growing contribution to India's renewable energy capacity. The wind farm is expected to offset approximately 26,350 tonnes of carbon dioxide emissions every year, ensuring a greener power supply.

A key highlight of the Karur project is the strategic unbundling of its scope into multiple packages, all executed directly by TPREL. Instead of depending on original equipment manufacturers for Balance of Plant (BOP), Civil BOP, engineering and construction, transmission lines, 33 kV systems and SY works, the project was delivered through a self-EPC model. This approach underscores TPREL's strong in-house capabilities, engineering expertise and ability to execute mega-scale wind projects independently.

The project faced several execution challenges, which were addressed through meticulous planning and innovative engineering solutions. Large turbine components were transported with minimal disruption to local communities, reflecting TPREL's responsible development practices. Excavation in hard rock formations was efficiently managed using advanced direct-to-hole machinery, while the movement of over 516 cubic metres of concrete within a 12-hour window highlighted strong coordination and project management.

Despite these challenges, the project was completed at record speed, with foundation work finished in just 126 days and wind turbine installation completed in 167 days. These achievements reinforce TPREL's reputation for rapid and resilient execution of large-scale renewable energy projects.

The partnership further strengthens TPREL's leadership role in India's clean energy transition and supports the national target of achieving 500 GW of renewable energy capacity by 2030. It also reflects the company's focus on scaling up wind-led projects that are reliable, dispatchable and economically viable.

TPREL currently has a wind energy portfolio exceeding 3.7 GW, of which more than 1.2 GW is operational. The remaining capacity is under various stages of development across Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Tamil Nadu.

Seminar on US immigration

Chennai, Feb 6: The Law Offices of Nadadur S. Kumar conducted an exclusive seminar at Taj Coromandel, Chennai, focusing on the evolving U.S. immigration landscape and strategic pathways for Indian students, professionals, investors and families. The session covered student, work and visitor visas, along with the EB-5 investor programme, amid heightened global scrutiny and the newly announced Indo-US trade agreement.

"Immigration today is at the centre of global political and economic debate, and Indian applicants face unprecedented scrutiny and delays, from visas to green card backlogs," said Mr. Nadadur S. Kumar, a U.S. immigration attorney with over 40 years of experience. He stressed that alternative options like the EB-5 investor programme have become increasingly important.

Kumar noted that while the Indo-US trade agreement does not currently include immigration provisions, it marks the first phase of a broader framework and is expected to improve bilateral engagement. He added that immigration, being politically sensitive, may be addressed in later negotiation phases after key U.S. elections. Visa Rules and Policy Shifts. He pointed out that although F-1 student visa rules remain largely unchanged, consular scrutiny has intensified, making first applications critical.

TN lays foundation for Knowledge City at Global Education Summit

Chennai, Feb 6: Hindustan Group of Institutions (HGI) participated as a Founding Partner of the India Global Education Summit (IGES) 2026, organised by the Government of Tamil Nadu in collaboration with NISAU UK at Kalaivaran Arangam, Chennai, reinforcing the institution's focus on global academic collaboration and international engagement.

IGES 2026 brought together policymakers, academic leaders, industry representatives and global education partners from over 20 countries and 400 institutions, providing a platform for dialogue on higher education, research and student mobility.

HGI's engagement at IGES 2026 reflects its continued efforts to strengthen international partnerships and global academic networks.

1,500 dead crows confirm Bird Flu: Chennai on high alert

Chennai, Feb 6:

Chennai has been placed on high alert following the death of more than 1,500 crows across several neighbourhoods in recent days, after laboratory tests

confirmed avian influenza (bird flu). In response, the Union government has directed the Tamil Nadu administration to intensify surveillance and disease-control measures to prevent further spread.

The unusual spate of crow deaths was reported from multiple areas, including Adayar, Gandhi Nagar, Pallikaranai, Velachery, Thiruvanmiyur, the East Coast Road (ECR) and the Old Mahabalipuram Road (OMR) corridor. Residents reported crows suddenly collapsing in public places, on trees and within residential

localities, raising alarm among civic and animal health authorities.

Acting promptly, the Animal Disease Investigation Team from Kanchipuram collected samples from the dead birds last month. These were sent to the National Institute of Animal Disease Control in Bhopal for testing, which has since confirmed the presence of avian influenza among the affected birds.

In view of the potential risk of the virus spreading to other animals and, in rare instances, humans,

the Central Veterinary Research Institute has written to the Tamil Nadu Chief Secretary, calling for immediate and strengthened precautionary measures.
